Council Meeting Minutes

February 21st, 2023

Absent: Colleen Klatt

Meeting was called to order by Jim Day at 7:00PM. Pastor shared prayer. Mary shared devotions.

Standing Agenda items:

Pastor asked to add an item to correspondence. Kris made motion to approve agenda. Mike seconded. All in favor.

Jim moved to approve minutes from 1/17/23. Mary seconded. All in favor.

Butch has contacted American Insurance Group about alternative insurance cost. The company requested a Zoom meeting with him. He let council know anyone is welcome to join. Time constraints make it difficult to change companies now because premium is due March 1. This change would require council approval. Butch will still do Zoom call to gather information. Pastor shared that every 3 years there is an opportunity to go online and complete the Safe Church Risk Management Survey. He did that and it should make our premium approximately \$1700 less. The workman's comp. fee is less than budgeted.

Financial Report: Steve stated January's general fund monthly income and expenses report ended with \$6,467.40. Budget to Actual report shows 121.3% for January offerings. \$5,734.50 over budget general fund income.

Colleen submitted an <u>extensive</u> coffee with council report prior to this meeting. She already shared members' areas of concern with prospective boards and committees.

Consent Agenda: Reports were received from Pastor, Event Coordinator, Christian Ed., Worship Board, Family Fellowship, PGE. Kris asked to pull **Christian Ed.**

Amy Conway was present to report from Christian Education Board that they recommend formation of a task force to look into where the future of Youth and Family is headed at MOLC. Jenifer stated that it's important to do the ministries here that this congregation wants. What do they really want? Kris asked to put this task force under unfinished business as a regular part of the monthly meeting agenda so that actual progress can be reported. Steve voiced that this task force may not be necessary once the Long-Range Planning has started (retreat date will be set at this meeting). Pastor commented that camp will be encouraged for the few youth we have and that there will be a confirmation class. Shelly volunteered to take over_VBS this summer. Shelly made motion to approve **C**onsent **A**genda and Butch seconded. **CA** passes.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

Building Pay Off completed

<u>Fundraising Policy</u>. Everyone was told to take home and review the policy sheet and the form groups will use and report back any changes they suggest at NEXT MEETING.

NEW BUSINESS:

Woodshop Fundraiser: Butch moved to approve Woodshop Fundraiser for March 25,26 Mary seconded. Motion passed.

Personnel

Steve explained Exe. Comm. met to discuss change in hours for full time employees. They are recommending council approve 32-40 hours per week instead of the traditional 40. This gives employees same benefits, but also have some flexibility to make personal appointments. Shelly made motion to change full time employee hours from 40 to 32-40. Mary seconded. Motion carried.

February 21st, 2023

Council was given new Job Description/Title change for Jenifer Clark. Her responsibilities have been increasing over the last few years and are still evolving. Exe. Comm. officers are also recommending her job description and job title be revised. Mary made motion that the job description/title be revised as printed in packet. Discussion included pastor wanting the job title to include "Communications". Motion amended to change job description and revise title to be

PROGRAM/COMMUNICATIONS MANAGER. Kris seconded. Approved by all.

- Shelly made motion to approve Network Table's Easter Breakfast fundraiser form.

 Mike seconded. Passed.
- Jim suggested 2 dates <u>April 22 or 29, for retreat to have a council work session on Long Range Planning.</u>
- \$10,181 has been donated to the fire fund to clean up the property owned by Robin Miller in Desert Hills. The estimated cost is \$12,000. It was learned she had hired a crew to clean up some prior to us getting involved. They need to be paid \$1,200. Pastor made motion to use \$5,000, some of the money that remains from paying off our debt for this fire fund. Shelly seconded. Motion approved.
- Nominating Committee: An oversight happened where a committee was not elected (as our constitution states) at the May annual meeting last year. Jim called The Synod for guidance and was told this is easy to resolve. Janet, Jeff, Mikey and Butch are the outgoing council members this year. Two of them must be part of the committee. At the Annual Congregational meeting on May 7th new council members will be elected. Butch agreed to recruit 3 candidates.
- <u>Synod Assembly Delegates</u>: Event is in Tucson this year. Dates are June 9,10. Let pastor know if you want to attend as soon as possible.
- Network Table is asking council for permission to do an online Fundraiser. Shelly made motion to approve. Mary seconded. Motion carried.

Walk On Items:

Kris asked if personnel committee is having meetings. She is liaison but has not been notified. Kris made motion to add Renee Jennings to personnel committee. Shelly seconded. Motion passed. She also noted that first aid kit in Parish Center needs some updating.

Motion to adjourn given at 8:15 by Butch, seconded by Karol. Prayer
