Message from our Pastor

As we enter into the month of June, we will be seeing a shift in our worship schedule. Starting the weekend of June 17-18, we will be moving to two worship times. We will stay with the Traditional Worship service on Saturday evenings at 5:00 pm. On Sunday, June 18, there will one worship service starting at 9:00 am. We are referring to it as a Blended Service. It will have a mixture of traditional music with piano and organ and it will have Praise Band Music as well. Holy Communion will be celebrated at the 5:00 pm worship on the 1st, 3rd and 5th Saturday of each month. Holy Communion will be celebrated every Sunday during the Blended Service schedule throughout the summer.

The Friendship Café will be open on Sunday from 8:00 am thru 11:00 am. The Blended Service schedule will continue through the weekend of August 13, 2023. Council Meeting Minutes

April 18, 2023

Absent: none

I. Call to order: Meeting was called to order at 7:00PM by Jim Day. Pastor shared prayer and Jeff read devotions.

II. Standing Agenda Items:

- **A.** Jim made motion to add **Nominating Committee** to OLD BUSINESS and **Van transportation** under NEW BUSINESS. Mary seconded. All in favor of amended agenda.
- **B.** Colleen made motion to accept minutes with corrections. Mike seconded. Passed.
- C. Correspondence: none to report
- **D. Financial report:** March income and expenses show net income at \$11,490.01. Offerings to general fund are favorable. <u>January through March</u> budget offerings are at 115.9%. <u>This</u> report still gives deficit; however, it is less than previous months! Kris moved to accept financial report and Karol seconded. All in favor.
- **E.** <u>Coffee with Council feedback:</u> Karol gave a wonderfully detailed report of her conversations. Some of the concerns included: <u>many praises for pastor</u>, new microphones for praise band, pastor preaching from the pulpit, and choir wearing robes more often. Time set for coffee with council only allows for those attending on Sundays to share their concerns. Need to find a way for Saturday night people to voice their thoughts as well.
- **F.** <u>Consent Agenda:</u> Reports from Outreach, Pastor, Christian Ed., Altar Guild (Worship Board), Family Fellowship and Personnel Committee were submitted in council packet prior to this meeting. Kris asked that Personnel report be pulled and Jim wanted Pastor's report to review also. Shelly moved to approve **CA** and Mary seconded.

Jim wanted clarification on the summer worship from Pastor's report. There are only 9 Sundays of a blended form of contemporary and traditional worship at 9AM. This could result in communion every Sunday. Worship Board will put together an example of this format and have it emailed hoping it's a solution for the reluctant individuals.

Kris, as council liaison for Personnel Board, made motion to accept Ernie Swanson and Herb Anderson be added to this board. Colleen seconded. Motion carried.

III. Unfinished Business:

Final draft of Fundraising Policy and Application Form, revised by Exec. Comm., was included in packet. Butch made motion to approve new fundraising policy and application form. Janet seconded. Motion passed.

Steve made motion (which is the recommendation from Executive Committee) that the funds from the White Burro Sale be distributed as follows: \$2000 Faith and Grace, \$2000 to Clothes Closet, and \$1000 to Network Table. Kris seconded. Motion carried.

Surplus Funds: Butch would like everyone to seriously think about our priority needs because there is approximately \$50,000 remaining from the debt reduction donation. These will be discussed at the April 22 working session. Shelly suggested the members who have a schedule conflict and can't attend this session, email their thoughts.

Nominating Committee report was in the packet. Background info on council candidates will be available in the annual report. Thank you to the committee members: Bev Swanson, Annie Archer, Lynda Anderson, Janet Pippin, and Butch Shaffer who met several times and were able to recruit these candidates: Butch Shaffer, Jeff Bodnar Jr., Ernie Swanson, Craig Medhaug, Steve Philo and Susan Leifer.

IV. New Business:

A. <u>Audit Committee:</u> Steve will reconcile year 2022 and recruit people. Constitution states this committee must have 3 elected members.

- **B**. Jim reported there are 5-6 members who live at The Views who would like to be picked up by our van. He asked for us to try to recruit drivers because we have a limited number of approved drivers now. Butch volunteered to install running boards on the van. One resident there drives himself to late service. Our van would give others a chance to attend at a different time.
- **V. Adjourn:** Kris made motion to adjourn meeting. Karol seconded. Meeting adjourned with the Lord's Prayer at 8:02PM
