#### Message from our Pastor

Just as a point of reference, three years ago, we as a country, world and local faith community were still in the midst of the Covid-19 pandemic. We had not worshipped in the sanctuary for about 4-5 months and we were just resuming worshipping in person. Obviously, we had safety precautions in place with distancing and masking, but we were together. We were also in the process of having the new camera system installed in the sanctuary to enhance our livestream capabilities. What a blessing this new system has been.

We have come a long way since that time 3 years ago and there is a sense of normalcy. In-person worship has still not recovered or come back from what it was pre-covid. Our winter visitor worshiping community has come back steadily but still lagging. We have seen a significant increase in livestream attendance and many of the other ways that we reach out into our community with social media are seeing either steady or modest increases in participation. Many of our home bound members are truly grateful for the opportunity to still have the weekly worship connection with us. That is only a small portion of the people we are reaching. Many of our winter visitors tune in regularly as well as many former members who have moved away.

Retiring the debt has also been "a positive" for the congregation as we seem to have a much better revenue stream with weekly offerings. Removing a monthly obligation of \$6,000 toward debt reduction lifted a great burden from our operating expenditures. The online or electronic giving and the use of ACH bank processing has also provided for a convenient way for people to support the ongoing ministry here at Mount Olive.

# Kevin Jackson Praise Band Director

When I asked Kevin if there was anything he'd like the congregation to know about him, he was very open and honest in telling his story. We all know that simply being raised Lutheran doesn't necessarily mean our lives will be easy, but we do know that our faith teaches us that God will always be with us! Kevin had drifted into a path of alcohol, drugs and eventually prison. While in prison, God spoke to Kevin telling him that he was going to serve God...either behind those prison walls or in front of them. He also met a "fallen preacher" in prison that prophesied to Kevin that he would "Go to the desert and change the church". Kevin didn't live in the desert, he lived in the L.A. area in California, so after being released from prison, he returned home and joined a church where he was given the opportunity to play music for the children...every once in a while. He didn't feel this was exactly what God meant by "Changing the church". He eventually came to Lake Havasu visiting his friend (and ours!), Vereen White. Vereen kept encouraging Kevin to come to Mount Olive. After a long while, he finally did and was encouraged by Marcella, our Choir Director at the time, and Pr. Jim Price to help start a contemporary music service. As the contemporary service grew and became successful, Pr. Jim told Kevin that he had, "Come to the desert and changed the church!"...the very same words prophesied to Kevin years ago! Confirmation that Kevin knew he was following the path God had in store for him by living his favorite Bible verses from Joshua Chap. 1, "Be of good courage and do not be afraid!". I think those of us that have been blessed by Kevin's musical talents would agree! When you see Kevin, please congratulate him on his 11th anniversary at Mount Olive!



#### UPDATE: Network Tables for Child Care Centers Expansion in Arizona

In our final Network Table update, we'd like to share a little more about where Open Table is headed with network tables for child care centers. **We'd like to highlight what is coming for Lake Havasu!** 

As noted in February, our success has helped Open Table receive grants to support additional tables in Arizona. Ten tables in Phoenix and five tables for various locations in the state are in various planning stages. **Open Table partnered with Zion Institute** (<a href="www.thezioninstitute.org">www.thezioninstitute.org</a>) in South Phoenix. Zion Institute's mission is to help South Phoenix communities break the cycle of generational poverty by partnering with service organizations, small businesses, and other community members. Open Table trained a network table to support **two new child care centers** who are being mentored by Zion Institute: **Much Moore Academy and Imagination Learning Center**. Much Moore plans to open soon and Imagination Learning Center received their license mid-August. Their Network Table is hard at work, helping them move ahead.

The grant application submitted by Open Table to Lake Havasu City was accepted earlier this year. **Open Table received a grant to support five more tables in Lake Havasu!** The Open Table team is planning table recruiting events and outreach to the local child care centers. The new network tables may be church-based, community organization-based, or made up of any interested community individuals. **Please pray for the expansion of network tables in our community.** If you are interested in participating or know anyone you think may be interested, please have them contact Kim Corbin

#### **Council Meeting Minutes**

July 18, 2023

**Call to Order:** President Shelly Hales called to order the regular meeting of the Mount Olive Lutheran Church Council at 7:00 pm on July 18, 2023 in the Lakeview Room.

**In Attendance:** Shelly Hales, Jim Day, Susan Leifer, Pastor Craig, Jeff Bodnar Jr., Karol Falsetti, Mary Hawkins, Hannah Joy and Kris Kidder.

Devotions and Opening Prayer: Pastor Craig led us in opening prayer. Susan Leifer shared a devotion.

Additions to the Agenda: Shelly Hales recognized Jeff Bodnar, Jr. and thanked him for his service on Council. Congratulations to Jeff who was hired as our Church custodian. As a paid employee, he can no longer serve on Council and was dismissed from the meeting. Shelly Hales then called for any additions to the agenda. Jim Day asked that the new Council position opening and Council nominating committee be added to New Business. Mary Hawkins moved to accept the agenda as amended. Karol Falsetti seconded. Motion carried.

Minutes from the Last Meeting: Shelly Hales called for any corrections or additions to the June 20, 2023 minutes. Although not a correction, Kris Kidder raised a question about the Bookkeeping position being exempt from a formal job description because it IS a paid position at this time. She will bring it up again at the next meeting of the Personnel Committee. Pastor Craig noted an error in the spelling of Jesse and Jen's last name. Jim Day moved to approve the minutes as corrected. Kris Kidder seconded. Motion carried.

**Correspondence:** Jim Day stated that two thank you notes were received by the Woodshop. The hospital wrote to thank them for the new altar for their chapel. The Clothes Closet thanked them for the new shelving.

**Financials:** Jim Day presented the financial reports for June 2023. Month to date we show a deficit of approximately \$3,100. Year to date we are to the good by approximately \$7,425. Shelly Hales pointed out that June's Network Table restricted fund shows a balance of \$125. This fund was to be closed and all monies moved to Vacation Bible School. Jim reported that the May 2023 balance for the Liberia Fund was not carried forward to June's report. Jim also presented the May 2023 restricted fund report with a minor correction to Outreach. Kris Kidder moved to accept the reports as corrected. Hannah Joy seconded. Motion carried.

**Coffee with the Council Update:** Mary Hawkins gave feedback from July's Coffee with Council. No concerns were voiced. Saturday evening service members appreciated the initiative Mary took to arrive before the service to be available for any concerns they may have. Thank you, Mary!

Consent Agenda: Shelly Hales moved to accept the consent agenda with the following reports received: Columbarium, Outreach, Pastor's Report, Planned Giving & Endowment and Program & Communications Manager. Shelly Hales noted that Network Table should be removed the list. Jim Day moved to accept the consent agenda. Kris Kidder seconded. Motion carried.

Council Seat Vacated by Jeff Bodnar: Jim Day moved to leave the position vacant (as provided for in our constitution) until the general election in December of this year. At that time we will vote for 4 members to serve a 3 year term and 1 replacement member to serve a 2 year term. Karol Falsetti seconded. Motion carried.

**Call to the Congregation:** Wanda Shockley needs the details/information for the upcoming Sept. 17<sup>th</sup> special meeting by Thursday July 20<sup>th</sup> in order for it to be included in the August Olive Branch.

**Motion to Adjourn:** Shelly Hales moved to adjourn. Mary Hawkins seconded. Motion carried. President Shelly Hales adjourned the meeting at 7:45p.m. The meeting closed with the Lord's Prayer.
